

of construction of buildings for the Cambridge Hospital, five thousand dollars for the purpose of construction of buildings for Charlotte Hall School, five thousand dollars for the purpose of construction of buildings for St. Mary's Academy, four thousand dollars for the purpose of construction of buildings for St. Mary's Female Seminary, one hundred and seventy-five thousand dollars for the purchase of a lot of ground in the City of Baltimore for the Maryland Institute and the construction of a building thereon, and two hundred and fifty thousand dollars for the Relief Fund Commission, under Chapter 129 of the Acts of 1904; and the said respective sums shall be paid by the Treasurer upon the warrant of the Comptroller to the person or persons, commission or commissions, body or bodies corporate, entitled to receive the same upon written orders from time to time as such sums may be required. And the building commission created by an Act passed at the January Session of 1902, Chapter 332, to erect said addition to the State House, being hereby declared entitled to receive the first-named sum of six hundred thousand dollars, and the board of managers of the Maryland House of Correction being hereby declared entitled to receive the sum of two hundred thousand dollars herein mentioned as its proportion of this loan.

Treasurer to pay on warrant of Comptroller.

To sell part or parts of loan.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That if the purpose contemplated by this Act should not demand an immediate sale of the certificates provided for by this Act, the Governor, Comptroller of the Treasury and Treasurer, or a majority of them, may issue advertisements from time to time in accordance with the provisions of this Act for such part or parts of said loan as may from time to time be required.

Appropriation for expenses.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That the sum of ten thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated for the payment of the expenses of the engraving, printing and other outlays connected with the issue of the loan hereby authorized, and for the payment of the advertisement directed by this Act, and all other incidental expenses connected with the execution of its provisions.

To levy a tax for redemption of bonds.

SEC. 7. *And be it enacted*, That the County Commissioners of this State and the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore are directed to levy the State taxes for the year 1904 at one cent on each one hundred dollars, and annually thereafter at two cents on each one hundred dollars of assessable property, to be collected according to law to meet the interest and create a sinking fund for the redemption of the "Public Building Loan," created under the provisions of this Act.
