CHAPTER 245.

AN ACT to prohibit the sale of spirituous or fermented liquors, or lager beer, within one mile of the northeast corner of the District of Columbia in Prince George's County, Maryland.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That it shall not be lawful for the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Prince George's County, Maryland, to issue license to any person, persons or corporation to sell spirituous or fermented liquors, or lager beer, in Prince George's County, Maryland, within one mile in every direction from the northeast corner of the District of Columbia.

CHAPTER 246.

AN ACT to incorporate the Maryland Insurance Agency Company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That George F. Patterson, Theodore Cook, Jr., Thomas N. Walker, Jr., Harry T. Thomas and Charles T. Leviness, Jr., all of Baltimore City, and their successors and the holders of the stock hereinafter mentioned, be and they are hereby created a body corporate by the name of the Maryland Insurance Agency Company, and by that name shall have perpetual succession.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the said body corporate shall have the power to carry on and conduct a general insurance agency and a general insurance brokerage business; to act in this State and elsewhere as general, special or registered agent for all insurance companies duly authorized to do business in this State; and to do any and all other acts necessary and
