SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 250.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to meet the additional expenses of the Legislature of Maryland for the Session of 1904:

Expenses of Legislature. Whereas, Chapter 421 of the Acts of 1902 appropriated for the expenses of the Legislature of 1904 the sum of one hundred and thirty thousand dollars; and

Representation enlarged.

WHEREAS, Since the passage of said Act the representation in the Legislature of Maryland has been enlarged and the expenses thereof increased; therefore,

Extra appropriation. Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the sum of seventy thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated to pay the members and officers of the General Assembly, as well as all miscellaneous expenses of said Session of 1904, in accordance with Chapter 421 of the Acts of 1902.

State treasurer to disburse

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the Treasurer of the State shall, on the warrant of the Comptroller, disburse the said sum of money herein appropriated for the objects and purposes herein specified, to or upon the order of the person or persons entitled to receive the same.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 251.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact the following with amendments: Section 85M of Article 23 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Corporations," sub-title "General Regulations," and to add an additional section to be designated as Section 85N, providing for calling in and cancelling the stock of any such company.
