

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 45 of Article 72 of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Oysters," sub-title "State Fishery Force," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows:

State Fishery Force.

45. The commander of said force shall have control and direction of said force, under the supervision of the Board of Public Works, with power to direct its movements, and shall have an office, to which place all complaints and applications for assistance shall be addressed, and it shall be his duty to have kept an itemized account of all expenses and disbursements of said force and same report monthly to the Board of Public Works, accompanied by proper receipts and vouchers. The said commander shall be permitted to have a clerk at a salary of one thousand dollars per annum; said clerk shall remain at the office in Annapolis and issue, by power, all orders necessary for the proper maintenance and supply of said force; he shall, as often as practicable hold consultation with said commander and take orders from him for the duties which he is to perform, and in the absence of said commander, he shall, as required by the said commander, report fully to the Board of Public Works.

Commander to have control.

Clerk to commander.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 260.

AN ACT to change the dividing line between the second precinct of the Fourth Election District and the Seventh Election District of Montgomery County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the territory embraced within the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at the intersection of the road leading from Garrett Park with the turnpike leading from Rockville to Bethesda; thence with a straight line to the intersection of the Orendorf Mill road with the Old Georgetown road, near Bean postoffice; thence with the Old Georgetown road in the direction of Bethesda, to its intersection with the road petitioned for by F. W. Bangarter and others, as per plat recorded in Plat Book No. 1, Plat No. 51, of record in the Clerk's office of the Circuit Court for Montgomery County; thence with said last mentioned road to its intersection with
