On or before the first day of each month after said tax becomes due and payable they shall pay to the Treasurer of Cecil County the amount of the tax collected by them and remaining in their hands, less twenty-five per centum of said amount, and the Treasurer shall place the amount thus received to the credit of the sheep fund of the county.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 273.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Harford County to levy annually a sum of money for the support of Elias Peterson of said county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Harford County be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to levy annually a sum of money not to exceed one hundred dollars for the support of Elias Peterson of said county.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 274.

AN ACT to authorize the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to issue its certificate of stock to an amount not exceeding two million dollars for the purpose of providing the money to pay costs and expenses of condemning, opening, grading, paving and curbing the streets, avenues, lanes and alleys of the Annex portion of Baltimore City; and to authorize the appointment of a commission, to be known as the "Annex Improvement Commission," and to define the duties of said commission.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore be and are hereby authorized to issue stock to an amount not exceeding two million dollars, to be issued from time to time and payable at such time and bearing such rate of interest as the said Mayor and City Council of Baltimore shall by ordinance pre-
