of said county, a certain sum of money for taxes erroneously paid to said County Commissioners by her.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the said County Commissioners of Washington Refunding a certain sum County be and they are hereby authorized, empowered and of money. directed to refund and pay over to Mrs. Clara Hamilton, of said county, the sum of thirty dollars, being money which the said Mrs. Clara Hamilton paid to the said County Commissioners of Washington County for county taxes on property erroneously assessed to her by the said County Commissioners for the year 1901.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 30.

AN ACT to repeal Sections 233 and 235 of Article 20 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Somerset County," subtitle "Roads," and to re-enact said sections so as to read as follows:

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 233 and 235 of Article 20 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Somerset County," sub-title "Roads," be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

233. That each supervisor shall make a full report to the County Commissioners on blanks to be furnished by said Supervisors of Commissioners on the first day of June in each and every semi-annual year, setting forth in such report the names and color of all reports. able bodied persons residing in his district between the ages of twenty-one and fifty-five years, and compellable under the law to labor on roads in his district; and each supervisor shall also make reports to the County Commissioners on the first day of June, and the first day of December in each and every year, in which reports they shall state on blanks, to be furnished by the County Commissioners the times and places of all work done, the names and color of persons summoned and the time made by himself and each person at work on each occasion, the money received by him for all purposes from all sources, disbursements he has made, and on what account. and any other matter touching the road service in his district;
