

Penalty for failure to do so.

and if any road supervisor shall wilfully fail to file either the annual report, above referred to, or either of the above mentioned semi-annual reports, with the said County Commissioners, within ten days from the time herein required, respectively, his said office shall be *ipso facto* vacated and the said County Commissioners shall immediately proceed to appoint some other person in his stead.

Supervisor's compensation.

235. That each Supervisor shall receive as full compensation two dollars for each and every day of eight hours each, he may be employed in actually superintending persons duly summoned and actually engaged in clearing, smoothing and repairing the roads of his district, and also ten cents for each person summoned as aforesaid; *provided*, the number so summoned shall not exceed ten persons at any one time; and if it shall become necessary for any road supervisor by reason of sudden flood or by reason of accident or other emergency, to work upon the roads of his district alone, or to repair bridges, without the assistance of persons liable to road service and regularly summoned such road supervisor shall be entitled as his full compensation for services thus rendered, to the sum of one dollar and twenty-five cents per day, for each and every day of eight hours each in which he may be actually so employed and if under any circumstances any road supervisor shall find it necessary to furnish a horse and wagon or cart, while engaged in road service he shall receive as compensation for such horse and cart or wagon if in the judgment of the County Commissioners, such horse and wagon were necessary, the sum of one dollar for each and every day of eight hours each he may have employed said horse and wagon but, under no circumstances shall any allowance be made by the County Commissioners to any road supervisor for the use of any horse and wagon or cart, unless such horse and wagon or cart was actually and necessarily used by such supervisor in the discharge of his duties; and each supervisor shall be required by the County Commissioners to give bond to the State in the sum of five hundred dollars with surety to be approved by the County Commissioners conditioned for faithful discharge of his duty; and said bond shall be on file in the office of said Commissioners and may be put in suit by the said Commissioners, or any one suffering from the neglect of said supervisor in keeping his road in proper order, or any other failure of duty; and the said supervisor shall also be liable to indictment in the Circuit Court for Somerset County, and on conviction for any violation of his duties under the subtitle of this Article shall be fined not exceeding two hundred
