dollars, and shall stand committed until said fine and costs are paid. All fines under this section to be paid to the County Penalty. Commissioners and to be applied by them to the use of the public roads in Somerset County.

CHAPTER 31.

AN ACT to provide for an additional Justice of the Peace in and for the Seventh Election District of Dorchester County.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland. That the Governor of the State be and he is hereby Additional Jusauthorized and empowered to appoint an additional Justice of tice of the Peace. the Peace in and for Election District Number Seven, in Dorchester County.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted. That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 32.

AN ACT to repeal Section 107 of Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, title "Prince George's County," sub-title "County Treasurer," as enacted by Chapter 331 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of the year 1902, and to re-enact said section with amendments.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland. That Section 107 of Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, title "Prince George's County," sub-title "County Treasurer," as enacted by Chapter 331 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of the year 1902 be and the same is hereby repealed, and said Section 107 re-enacted as follows:

107. Before entering upon the duties of his office, the Treasurer shall take an oath, in due form of law, before the Clerk County Treasurer shall take an oath. of the Circuit Court for Prince George's County, to perform the duties of his office; he shall also execute a good bond in performance the penalty of fifty thousand dollars for the faithful performance of his duties as Treasurer, and further conditioned that he shall well and truly account for and pay over to the person

of duty.
