

of the same shall be securely and conspicuously posted on the outside of the building in which the polls are held, before the balloting begins, in such position that the same may be easily examined by the public.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That all Acts or parts of Acts inconsistent with the provisions of this Act be and the same are hereby repealed, and this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 330.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money for the maintenance of the Fifth Regiment Armory.

Appropriation
to maintain
Fifth Regi-
ment Armory.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That for the purpose of maintaining the Fifth Regiment Armory until the thirtieth of September, 1906, the sum of four thousand dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated or so much thereof as may be necessary, and the Treasurer of the State on warrant of the Comptroller, shall disburse the said sum to and upon the order of the Board of Trustees of the Fifth Regiment Armory, for the purposes herein specified.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from and after the first day of October, 1904.

CHAPTER 331.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money to pay Robert B. Forwood for taxes erroneously paid by him into the State Treasury.

Refunding
moneys paid
erroneously
for taxes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Comptroller of the State be and he is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant on the Treasurer of the State in favor of Robert B. Forwood for the sum of twelve dollars, being the amount erroneously paid by him into the State Treasury for taxes for the years 1898 to 1902, inclusive.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
