Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Article 22 of the Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Washington County," sub-title "Williamsport," be and Williamsport, Washington the same is hereby amended by adding thereto Sections 411A County, Md. and 411B, to follow Section 411 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, Chapter 17, and approved February 25, 1904, being an Act repealing and re-enacting the charter of Williamsport.

411A. The Burgess and Commissioners of Williamsport are hereby authorized and empowered to contract with any person, Lighting of persons or corporation for the lighting of the streets, alleys and public places of said town, and to provide for the payment of such lighting.

411B. The Burgess and Commissioners of Williamsport are hereby authorized and empowered to grant the use of the streets Granting cerand highways of said town to any street railway company and prescribe the terms and conditions upon which the same may be used, and all ordinances heretofore passed for such use are hereby ratified and confirmed.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 156, 157, 174, 180, 185, 270B, 270G, 270J, 270N, 270P, 270W, 270Y, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Frederick County," sub-title "Frederick Frederick City, City," relating to registration and elections in said city, as County, Md. the same were amended by the Acts of 1898, Chapters 1 and 2, be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

156. All male citizens of Maryland above the age of twentyone years, who shall be citizens of the United States and who
