

be paid not later than the 10th day of the succeeding month, unless said 25th day or 10th day of any month shall fall on Sunday or a legal holiday, in which case the time for payment shall be extended to the next day.

Penalty for violation of this Act.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That any such corporation, refusing to make said payment of wages at the time hereinbefore specified, or wilfully withholding said wages from said employees beyond said times, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon indictment and conviction thereof, shall be fined not less than fifty dollars nor more than three hundred dollars, in the discretion of the court.

CHAPTER 38.

AN ACT to prohibit the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County from hereafter paying any pension and from hereafter levying any sum of money upon the taxable property of Queen Anne's County for the purpose of paying any pension to any person who is now, or who shall hereafter become a non-resident of Queen Anne's County aforesaid and to repeal all Acts inconsistent with this Act.

Prohibiting paying of pensions to non-residents.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County shall not hereafter pay any pension, or levy any sum of money upon the taxable property of said county for the purpose of paying any pension, to any person who is now or who shall hereafter become a non-resident of said county.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That all Acts inconsistent with this Act, be and the same are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 39.

AN ACT to provide payment for the publishing of the Annual Report and official blanks, and for an anemometer for the State Mine Inspector, as required by Chapter 124 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1902, January Session.

Mine Inspector.

WHEREAS, In Chapter 124 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1902, at the January Session, it was provided that the State should furnish the Mine Inspector with printed blanks
