powered to borrow in case said bridge and the roadbeds leading thereto are purchased or acquired for said county, such county to borsum of money as may be sufficient to pay for the said bridge row funds. and the roadbeds leading thereto, at a rate of interest not to exceed four per cent per annum, and to execute good and valid notes or bonds therefor as County Commissioners on the credit of the said county.

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That the County Commissioners To levy such shall in each and every year levy upon the assessable property sum as may be necessary. in Frederick County such sum of money as may be necessary to pay the interest on the outstanding notes or bonds by them executed in pursuance of this Act, as the same shall become due and payable, or to pay for the use of said bridge and the roadbeds leading thereto, in case the same are leased by said County Commissioners in pursuance of this Act, and such further and additional sums as may be required to gradually pay off said notes or bonds as they may become due; and said taxes authorized by this Act shall be collected as other taxes are collected.

SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
