## CHAPTER 374.

AN ACT authorizing the Bachman Valley Railroad Company to cease its operations and to sell and dispose of its property.

WHEREAS, The Bachman Valley Railroad Company owns a Bachman Valley Railroad railroad in Carroll County, Maryland, about three miles in leg Railroad Company. length, extending from Ebbrale, in Manchester District, Carroll County, Maryland, to a point on the boundary line between Maryland and Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, The said Bachman Valley Railroad Company Loss to stockceased active operations a number of years past and cannot holders. be conducted except at a great loss to its stockholders; and

WHEREAS, Its insignificant length and operations make its Insignificant continued existence no longer of public interest and value; length. therefore,

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Mary-Authorized to land, That the Bachman Valley Railroad Company is author-tions. ized to cease its operations as a railroad and to sell and dispose of its property of every nature and kind; provided, that three-fourths of all the stock of said Bachman Valley Railroad Company shall be first voted at a meeting of stockholders called for that purpose in favor of both ceasing the operations of said railroad and of selling and disposing of its property.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 375.

AN ACT to authorize and require the County Commissioners of Calvert County to levy a sum of money to build a school house for white children at or near Bowens, in Election District No. 2, to replace School house No. 1.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Mary-Levying a sum land, That the County Commissioners of Calvert County are of money to bereby supported and required to law upon the accessful. hereby authorized and required to levy upon the assessable house. property of Calvert County, at the next levy, the sum of five hundred dollars for the use of the School Commissioners of said county to build a school house for white children at or near Bowens, in District No. 2, to replace School No. 1.
