CHAPTER 45.

AN ACT to authorize and empower Joseph H. Bernard, Thomas H. Jarman, Thomas C. Curry, Robert I. Raughley, William J. Moore, Clinton B. Jarman, Thomas F. Jackson, Samuel J. Bilbrough and Henry Tothwate, Trustees of the Methodist Episcopal Church in Greensboro, Caroline County, Maryland, or a majority of them, to sell said church and apply the proceeds arising from said sale to the building and completion of the new Methodist Episcopal Church now being erected in said town of Greensboro, Maryland.

Section I. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of MaryProvision for land, That Joseph H. Bernard, Thomas H. Jarman, Thomas

CHAPTER 46.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact Section 3 of Chapter 175 of the Acts of 1896, entitled "An Act to amend and extend the Charter of the Mutual Fire Insurance Company in Baltimore County."

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 3 of Chapter 175 of the Acts of 1896 be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

3. That it shall be the duty of the president or secretary of the Mutual Fire Insurance Company, in Baltimore County,
