Sec. 5. And be it enacted, That a majority of all the trustees Quorum. shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business, and said Board may appoint from their number a president, vicepresident, treasurer, secretary, and such other officers as said Board may deem necessary, in the manner, at the time, and for the term to be prescribed in the by-laws. Every trustee of said corporation before proceeding to act shall qualify by taking the test oath required by the Constitution and laws of the State of Maryland, a certificate of which qualification shall be recorded on the minutes of the proceedings of the Board of

SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That the said Board of Trustees Authority to be, and they are hereby, authorized and empowered to enter into contracts with the County Commissioners of Washington County, and the Mayor and Council of Hagerstown, providing for the receipt of revenues, in perpetuity, in aid of said hospital.

SEC. 7. And be it enacted, That the real and personal estate Real and personal estate authorized by this Act to be held by the said "The Washington County Hospital Association" for the uses and purposes herein provided for, shall be exempt from all state, county and municipal taxes so long as the same shall be used for the purposes herein mentioned.

Sec. 8. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 383.

AN ACT to create a new Election District in Allegany County, to be known and designated as the Twenty-eighth Election District of Allegany County.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Mary-New election land, That a new Election District be formed and laid out of the Twenty-sixth Election District of Allegany County, to be known and distinguished as the "Twenty-eighth Election District of Allegany County," that precinct one of the Twenty-sixth Election District to be known hereafter as the Twenty-sixth Election District of Allegany County; and precinct two of the Twenty-sixth Election District be known hereafter as the Twenty-eighth Election District of Allegany County.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
