That it shall be the duty of the Treasurer to attend Time of attendance in each election district of Talbot County one day in the month of August and one day in the month of December of each year to collect taxes, and he shall give at least two weeks' notice of the time and place of such attendance in the various districts by handbills announcing the same conspicuously posted in each election district of Talbot County and by advertising in two or more newspapers published in Talbot County. and said notice and advertisement shall contain a brief statement of the discount allowed and interest charged on tax bills.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 386.

AN ACT to add an additional section to Article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Charter," said section to follow Section 51 of said Article, and to be designated as Section 51A.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Mary-Charter-City of Baltiland, That an additional section be, and the same hereby is, added to Article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Charter," said section to follow Section 51 of said Article, and to be designated as Section 51A, and to read as follows:

51A. In all cases where the City Collector shall commence Enforcement and carry on proceedings for the enforcement and collection of taxes under the provisions of this Article, whether by notice, distraint, levy, advertisement, sale, report of sale or otherwise, and the term of office of such City Collector shall expire or shall cease by death, resignation, removal or otherwise, before such proceedings are completed, and, in case of sale, before the said sale has been fully ratified and confirmed and a deed to the purchaser executed and delivered as provided in this Article, the successor in office of such City Collector whose term of office shall thus cease or expire is hereby authorized, empowered and required to continue and complete all said proceedings commenced and carried on as aforesaid, during the term of office of his said predecessor, in the same manner and with like effect as his said predecessor would have been authorized and empowered to do had his term of office not ceased and
