

expired as aforesaid; and the successor in office of such City Collector whose term of office shall thus cease or expire, shall have full power and authority to report any and all sales made by his said predecessor in office, to execute and deliver any and all deeds to property sold or reported by his said predecessor, and generally to do any and all acts and things necessary or proper to be done in order to continue and finally complete the enforcement and collection of taxes and the sale and conveyance of property therefor commenced and carried on by his said predecessor in office.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

#### CHAPTER 387.

AN ACT to limit the number on the Board of County Commissioners for Allegany County, title "Allegany County," subtitle "County Commissioners."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the three members of the Board of County Commissioners for Allegany County, elected in November, 1903, shall hold their said offices for a period of four years from the time of their election, or until their successors are elected and qualified, and that said three members of said Board on and after November, 1905, shall compose and constitute the Board of County Commissioners for Allegany County.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That no additional members shall be elected to the Board of County Commissioners for said Allegany County at the county election to be held in November, 1905.

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted*, That at the county election to be held in Allegany County in November, 1907, and at each two years thereafter, three members shall be elected to the Board of County Commissioners for Allegany County, who shall serve for the period of two years, or until their successors are elected and qualified.

Sec. 4. *And be it enacted*, That the members of the Board of County Commissioners on and after November, 1907, shall receive as full compensation for services as members of said Board the sum of five hundred dollars per annum, payable monthly.

Sec. 5. *And be it enacted*, That all Acts or parts of Acts inconsistent with this Act be, and the same are hereby, repealed.
