Sec. 7. And be it enacted, That the said Mayor and Council To select a shall select, in their discretion, some depository in which to deposit the money necessary for the payment of the principal and interest of said bonds as the same may mature and become due, provided, that the said Mayor and Council shall select by resolution said depository before issuing said bonds and shall designate the same on said bonds and the coupons thereto attached.

Sec. 8. And be it enacted, That all Acts or parts of Acts inconsistent with the provisions of this Act be, and the same are hereby, repealed.

Sec. 9. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 389.

AN ACT to repeal Sections 1, 8 and 9 of Chapter 160 of the Acts of 1902, entitled "An Act to create the State Board of Undertakers of Maryland, and to prescribe the powers and duties of the said Board," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Mary-State Board land, That Sections 1, 8 and 9 of Chapter 160 of the Acts of of Under 1902, entitled "An Act to create and establish the State Board of Undertakers of Maryland, and to prescribe the powers and duties of the said Board," be, and the same are hereby, repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Mary-Creation of land, That a Board composed of eight members be and the same is hereby created and established, to be known as the State Board of Undertakers of Maryland, and the powers and duties of the said Board prescribed.

8. Before any person, copartnership or corporation shall Pertaining to hereafter engage in the business of undertaking in the State of Maryland and before any member of any such copartnership, assistant or employee of any such person, copartnership or corporation or officer of such corporation whose engage him duties will or her in the care, preparation, disposition or burial of the dead shall discharge the duties of such business, employment or office, and before any person, copartnership or corporation now so engaged in said business of undertaking in this State; and before any member of any such copartnership, assistant or em-

ed in the business of Undertak-ing.
