

To appoint

101. The County Commissioners shall, at their first meeting in May, 1904, and annually thereafter, appoint as many road supervisors for each election district and precinct of the county as they may deem necessary for the proper working of said roads, said supervisors in all cases being selected with special regard to their knowledge and skill in directing road work, and shall be subject at all times to such rules and regulations as may be adopted by the County Commissioners, with regard to the repairing, mending and perfecting the public roads of said county. The said Commissioners shall also fix the compensation of road supervisors, and the per diem of all laborers employed to work on said roads.

Building
roads and
bridges.

102. The County Commissioners shall provide in their levy of 1904 a sufficient sum of money to pay all indebtedness on account of roads, and shall then, and annually thereafter, levy a sum not less than five thousand nor more than eight thousand dollars, for the building and repair of said roads in any one year; provided, that nothing in this section shall prevent the Commissioners from levying an additional amount to build any bridge, the cost of which will be one hundred dollars or more.

Apportion-
ment of
road funds.

103. The County Commissioners shall so soon after each annual levy as practicable apportion the sum so levied for public roads among the several election districts and precincts of the county, in exact proportion to the assessed basis of each district and precinct. They shall, as far as practicable, have all road work done in a permanent manner.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage, and that all Acts and parts of Acts inconsistent with this Act be and the same are hereby expressly repealed.

CHAPTER 408.

AN ACT to amend Article 13 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Harford County," sub-title "Fish," by adding thereto two sections, to be known as Sections 113 and 114.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the two following sections be added to and incorporated in Article 13 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Harford County," sub-title "Fish," to be known as Sections 113 and 114, and to read respectively as follows:
