

## LAWS OF MARYLAND.

Topographical Survey Commission to make rules, etc. accepted. Said Topographical Survey Commission is hereby authorized to make such rules and regulations regarding surveys, plots or plans relating to the location of avenues, streets or alleys as they may deem proper from time to time.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 434.

AN ACT to repeal Sections 117A and 117B of Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Prince George's County," sub-title "Treasurer," as enacted by Chapter 477 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of the year 1900, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Treasurer of Prince George's County, Md. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sections 117A and 117B of Article 17 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Prince George's County," sub-title "Treasurer," as enacted by Chapter 477 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of the year 1900, be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted as follows:

Tax sales of real estate. 117A. All tax sales of real estate shall be advertised for the full time hereinbefore required in two newspapers published in Prince George's County to be selected by the Treasurer, one of which newspapers shall be published in the town of Upper Marlboro and the other shall be published either in the town of Hyattsville or in the town of Laurel; provided, that newspapers so selected shall have been established in their respective towns at least two years preceding the date of the first publication of said advertisement; and the costs of such advertisement in and for each newspaper shall not exceed the sum of fifty cents for a tax sale, which sum of money shall be charged against the property offered for sale as items of cost. A tax sale shall consist of all the real estate in any election district of the county, advertised for sale and belonging to the same person. In the matter of sale of personal property for taxes, the Treasurer shall be allowed costs similar to those allowed by law in the cases of seizure and sale of personal property by distraints, except that he shall receive no fee or commission therein.

Clerk of Court to verify. 117B. The Clerk of the Circuit Court upon receiving from the Treasurer a list of real estate about to be advertised by him at tax sales shall verify the Treasurer's reference in said list
