

same may be inconsistent or in conflict with the special or general regulation or provisions, powers, rights and advantages conferred or intended to be conferred by this Act.

SEC. 8. *And be it enacted*, That the company hereby incorporated shall have the power to buy, lease, mine, quarry, trade, barter, convey, dig, operate in granite and other stone and minerals, as they may deem expedient for use of said corporation in any county in the State of Maryland as hereinafter provided, the said corporation shall have power and right to operate within any counties within the State of Maryland.

SEC. 9. *And be it enacted*, That the said corporation herein incorporated is hereby authorized to consolidate with such stone or granite companies deemed agreed upon between them or such corporations may purchase, lease or sell, or the same may be leased or acquired by it.

SEC. 10. *And be it enacted*, That the president and directors of said company may borrow from time to time for the corporate purposes of said company, such amounts of money as they may deem proper, and provide for the payment of the same and the interest thereon by mortgage or otherwise. The said president and directors may also issue certificates of stock in said company and make all proper and necessary provisions for the payments of dividends thereon.

SEC. 11. *And be it enacted*, That the corporation which said capital stock may be subscribed and paid for either in money or in land or in other property which the company is authorized to own for its corporate purposes. The issuing of such stock shall be first authorized by a majority of the stockholders of the company assembled in general meeting called in pursuance of the by-laws of the company.

SEC. 12. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Charles County to levy a sum of money not exceeding seven hundred dollars to build a suitable school house for white children at Rock Point, fifth election district of Charles County, Maryland, title "Charles County," sub-title "Public Schools."
