

LAWS OF MARYLAND.

To build
school house.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners of Charles County be and they are hereby authorized and empowered and directed to levy at their next levy a sum of money not exceeding seven hundred dollars for the purpose of building a suitable school-house for white children at Rock Point, Charles County, Maryland, fifth election district of said county.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 443.

AN ACT to add new sections to Article 21 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Talbot County," under a new sub-title "Cemetery," to come in said Article alphabetically, in proper place, and to be designated as Sections 40A, 40B and 40C, as follows:

Cemetery.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That new sections be and the same are hereby added to Article 21 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Talbot County," under a new sub-title "Cemetery," to come in alphabetically, in proper place, and to be designated as Sections 40A, 40B and 40C, and to read as follows:

Recording
plats of ceme-
teries.

40A. The Clerk of the Criminal Court of Talbot County shall provide from time to time as same may be needed a record book or books properly numbered and liberated with suitable index or indexes therein, and shall record therein free of charge and properly indexed the plat or plats of any cemetery now or hereafter, located in Talbot County owned by any town, corporation, incorporated church or religious denomination, with the divisions or sub-divisions thereof into lots, walks, avenues or otherwise; said plat or plats and the record thereof to show the name, location and dimensions of such cemetery or cemeteries and the divisions or sub-divisions thereof aforesaid, which shall also include a proper plat of each lot and be recorded as aforesaid by said clerk upon said plat or plats being brought by the owner thereof aforesaid to his office for such records; and it is hereby the duty of said owner or owners to have same so recorded and also all subsequent additions either in quantity or sub-division as aforesaid; and when and as often as said original shall be recorded, in whole or in part, it shall be examined and endorsed and delivered to the owner thereof.
