

CHAPTER 453.

AN ACT to pay the William J. C. Dulany Company of Baltimore City the sum of seventy-six dollars and one cent, balance due for printing the roster of soldiers and sailors of Maryland organizations during the Spanish-American war, as ordered by the House of Delegates for the Session of 1900.

WHEREAS, The William J. C. Dulany Company, of Baltimore City, was ordered by the House of Delegates of Maryland, at the Session of 1900, to print one thousand copies of the roster of the soldiers and sailors who served in Maryland organizations during the Spanish-American war; and were, by the terms of said order, to be paid the sum of six hundred dollars for such work, to be drawn from the money appropriated for the printing of that session; and

Roster of soldiers and sailors of this State in Spanish-American War.

WHEREAS, Said roster was completed according to the terms of said order and was accepted by the State; however, there remained from the money appropriated for printing for said session only the sum of five hundred and twenty-three dollars and ninety-nine cents, which sum only was handed over to the said William J. C. Dulany Company in payment for said work, and no other sum has been paid them on said account; therefore

Deficiency in printing appropriation.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer of the State for the sum of seventy-six dollars and one cent in favor of the William J. C. Dulany Company of Baltimore City on account of the balance due the said company for printing the roster as aforesaid.

Treasurer to issue warrant.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 454.

AN ACT to add mileage to the compensation of the Judges of the Orphans' Court for Queen Anne's County, Maryland.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That any Judge of the Orphans' Court for Queen Anne's County, Maryland, who shall reside further than five miles
