

Local Laws, title "St. Mary's County," sub-title, "Justices of the Peace," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments so as to read as follows: Justices of the peace.

56A. Whenever a justice of the peace for said county shall issue a summons for a defendant residing in a different election district from the said justice he shall, upon the request of the defendant, transmit the papers in the case to some justice of the district where the defendant resides, or if there be two or more defendants he shall transmit said papers to some justice in the district where any one of said defendants may reside, who shall try the same.

Right to transmit papers.

CHAPTER 462.

AN ACT to further amend the charter of the Ridgley Savings Bank of Caroline County, Maryland, and to change the name of the same.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Act of incorporation of the Ridgley Savings Bank of Caroline County, a corporation formed under the provisions of the Code of Public General Laws of the State, title "Corporations," as amended and enlarged by the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland passed at the present Session, be and the same is hereby further amended as follows:

Ridgley Savings Bank of Caroline County, Md.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the name of the Ridgley Savings Bank of Caroline County be and the same is hereby changed from "The Ridgley Savings Bank of Caroline County" to "The Bank of Ridgley," and by such name shall have perpetual succession, to sue and be sued, to plead and be pleaded in any court whatever, make and use a common seal and to alter and renew the same at pleasure.

Authority to change name.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
