

or for the purposes of defraying the expenses and cost of grading or regrading, pursuant to the authority of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, any street, lane, alley, public square or market space, or any part thereof, opened, widened, extended or straightened under or in connection with the plan of improvements adopted or to be adopted under the Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at its January Session in the year 1904, creating a commission on the burnt district of Baltimore City, and among other things defining its duties and powers and regulating its methods of procedure, or for the purpose of defraying the cost of any preliminary work or services done or rendered at the instance of the Mayor of the City of Baltimore or the members of the Board of Estimates, before the passage of said Act in relation to its objects, or for the purpose of defraying the cost of constructing, remodelling, altering, removing, repairing or straightening any sewer or drain within the territory known as "The Burnt District," or for the purpose of defraying the cost of repairing, remodelling, altering, removing or constructing any of the water mains, subways or conduits belonging to the City of Baltimore within the said "Burnt District," or for any one or more of said purposes.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

#### CHAPTER 464.

AN ACT to repeal Section 1 of Article 76 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Publication of Laws," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 1 of Article 76 of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Publication of Laws," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted as follows:

Publication of laws.

1. Every Public General Law which is made to take effect before the first day of June next, after the session at which it shall be passed, which the Governor and Attorney General shall direct, shall immediately after its passage be published at the expense of the State, daily, for three times in four newspapers of the City of Baltimore, one of which shall be in the German language, one of which shall be a law paper, and
