

cost are not paid, said persons so convicted shall be committed to the jail of Frederick County for three months, and on a conviction for a second offense, committed after the first conviction, shall be committed to the Maryland House of Correction for three months in default of the payment of said fine and costs. The right of appeal to the Circuit Court for Frederick County is hereby reserved to the party convicted on giving a bond in the penalty of one hundred dollars to the State of Maryland to prosecute his appeal with success at the next term of said court, with surety to be approved by the justice of the peace trying said case, and on an affirmation of said judgment the Circuit Court shall impose the same penalties provided by this Act.

Right of appeal.

43. Any persons offending against any of the provisions of Sections 39 and 41, and being convicted thereof before any justice of the peace in Frederick County, shall forfeit the fine therein named, one-half of which shall be paid to the school fund of the county and the other half to the informer, and if the offender after conviction shall fail or refuse to pay said fine and costs he shall be committed to the jail of Frederick County for not less than ten days nor more than thirty days.

Forfeit the fine.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 476.

AN ACT for the creation of a Tuberculosis Commission.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Governor of the State be and he is hereby authorized to appoint five persons, three of whom shall be physicians, who, by virtue of such appointment, shall constitute a commission to be known as the Tuberculosis Commission, whose duty it shall be to investigate the prevalence, distribution and causes of human tuberculosis in the State of Maryland, to determine its relations to the public health and welfare, and to devise ways and means for restricting and controlling said disease, and to investigate and report upon the proper construction, cost, equipment, maintenance and location of a sanatorium for the treatment of tuberculosis.

Governor to appoint a Tuberculosis Commission.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the members of said commission shall serve without pay, except expenses actually incurred, and shall continue in office for a term of two years from
