

quired to employ one or more competent architects under whose control and supervision, as to material and workmanship, such building shall be erected; the building committee shall also select proper furniture for the use of said public school house as well as determine the best method of keeping the school, having due regard for the safety and health of the pupils attending there, and shall at such times as it may deem proper, advertise for such furniture and heating plant, and shall award the contract or contracts to the lowest responsible bidder or bidders.

Awarding the contract.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That when said committee shall have contracted for the erection of said school building and the furnishing and heating thereof, it shall report the same to the Board of County School Commissioners, with the terms and conditions of such contract, and they shall also report the costs and expenses incurred and paid from time to time.

Report to County Board.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That for the purpose of paying for said lot or lots and for the erection and furnishing of said public school building, the School Commissioners for Prince George's County are hereby authorized and directed to borrow on the endorsement of the County Commissioners of Prince George's County, who are hereby directed to endorse such bonds on the faith and credit of said county, an amount not exceeding the sum of ten thousand dollars, and to issue coupon bonds therefor in sums of not less than one hundred dollars and not more than one thousand dollars each, to be signed by the president of said Board of School Commissioners and countersigned by the School Examiner of said Board, with the seal of said Board attached, and to be registered by the said School Examiner of Prince George's County in a separate book kept for that purpose, and said bonds shall bear interest at the rate of five per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually on the first day of May and the first day of November each year until said bonds shall be paid, and said bonds shall be forever exempt from all taxation for any purpose, and shall have printed on them "Reference to this Act as authorizing the issue thereof."

Right to borrow funds on coupon bonds

Interest.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That the School Commissioners of Prince George's County are hereby authorized and directed to retain each and every year from the sums of money paid to them by the County Commissioners of Prince George's County for the support of the public schools of Prince George's County, a sufficient amount of money to meet the interest and to create a sinking fund to pay the principal of said bonds as
