SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That all Acts and parts of Acts inconsistent with this Act be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency and no further.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from and after the first day of May, 1904.

CHAPTER 498.

AN ACT to add additional sections to Article 10 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Dorchester County," sub-title "Wild Fowl," to be designated as Sections 339, 340, 341 and 342.

Wild fowl.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the following sections to be designated as 339, 340, 341 and 342 be and the same are hereby added to the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Dorchester County," sub-title "Wild Fowl:"

Shooting on bidden.

339. It shall be lawful for the Hooper's Island Gunning Sundays for Club of Dorchester County to shoot or kill wild ducks, geese, brant and swan on any days except Sundays.

Foot bridge.

340. The Hooper's Island Gunning Club of Dorchester County is hereby given authority to construct a foot bridge or pass across any portion of its property not intersected by navigable water so as to afford means of access and egress to, from and over its property.

etc.

341. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to place any booby or stationary blind or to use any device for shooting or killing any wild game within three hundred yards of the property owned by the Hooper's Island Gunning Club of Dorchester County, located on Middle Hooper's Island, Dorchester County, Maryland.

Fines.

342. Any person or persons violating the provisions of Section 341 of this Act shall be subject to all the fines and penalties upon conviction contained in Section 337 for the violation of Sections 335 and 336 of this Act.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That all Acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed and that this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
