quire the use of the same for the purposes of the said com-Company's pany in the manner provided by the Code of Public General right to con-Laws, Article 23, and the amendments thereto, so far as the same may be applicable, and may condemn lands, easements, rights of way, material and privileges for the purpose of the company in the manner aforesaid, and shall have all other rights, privileges and powers which are granted by the General Laws, so far as the same are consistent herewith.

Sec. 5. And be it enacted, That said company may enter upon, grade, occupy or use any public road or highway; sub-To use any public hie ject, however, to the consent of the County Commissioners, and so as not to prevent the free and convenient travel over such roads by any person or vehicle, and may also enter upon, use and occupy the roadbed of any company whose charter has expired and which roadbed is not in actual use for any other purpose, or which has been abandoned by any defunct company.

- SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That the charter of said com-Perpetual charpany shall be perpetual.
- SEC. 7. And be it enacted, That the County Commissioners of Calvert County may, in their discretion, exempt the prop-Exemption for crty of said corporation formed hereby from county taxes five years. for a period of five years from the date of its beginning operations under this charter hereby granted.
- Sec. 8. And be it enacted, That the construction of the main Main line. line of said railroad shall be commenced within five years and completed within ten years from and after the passage of this Act.
- Sec. 9. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 503.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the board of managers of the Frederick City Hospital and Emergency Hospital, to issue diplomas to trained nurses trained in and graduated by said hospital.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the board of managers of the Frederick City Hospital and Emergency Hospital, a corporation duly incorporated under the General Incorporation Laws of the State of Mary-
