through any other person, give, pay, expend or contribute or promise to give, pay, expend or contribute any money, intoxicating liquors or other valuable thing to procure or promote my own, or any other person's nomination at the coming primary election, except money for my own personal expenses for traveling and for purposes properly incidental to traveling, for writing, printing and preparing for transmission any letter, circular or other publication not issued at regular intervals, whereby I may state my position or views upon public or other questions, for stationery, sample ballots and postage, for telegraph, telephone and other public messenger service, for announcing my candidacy, for expenses of meetings held in my behalf, and for other personal petty expenses. That I will file under oath with the chairman of the county committee a true itemized statement of my expenditures made in connection with my candidacy for nomination at or before the hour of ten o'clock A.M., on Thursday succeeding the coming primary election.

County committee chairman custodian of the moneys.

At the time said affidavit is filed with said chairman, the said candidate for nomination shall pay a fee to said chairman to defray the expenses herein provided, which shall be as follows: Judge of Circuit Court, \$200; Member of Congress, \$200; State Senator, \$30; State's Attorney, \$60; Sheriff, \$75; Clerk of Circuit Court, \$75; Register of Wills, \$75; Clerk of County Commissioners, \$40; Treasurer, \$40; Judge of Orphans' Court, \$10; County Commissioner, \$25; House of Delegates, \$10; County Surveyor, \$5; County Committeeman, \$0. And candidates for any other office shall pay such a fee as the party chairman may fix, and the rates above set forth shall prevail unless the county chairman shall determine that a smaller fee will be sufficient to defray the expenses of such primary election. Said fees to be used exclusively as a fund to defray expenses of announcing candidates, printing ballots, furnishing blanks and other necessary expenses for holding and conducting the primary election, and paying such expenses of the return judges as may be determined by the said convention of return judges. The chairman of the county committee shall be the custodian of the funds arising from said fees, and shall
