

give bond, to be approved by a majority of the executive committee, which bond may be put to suit for shortage or defalcation in the name of "The County Committee of the Party," which is hereby authorized to sue by that name, and which said committee shall designate in writing filed in the proceedings in the suit, to whom the judgment recovered shall be paid. The accounts of said chairman shall be audited by a committee of three selected by said executive committee.

113. Any candidate refusing or neglecting to comply with the provisions of this Act, as hereinbefore prescribed, shall be dropped from the list of candidates, and shall not be returned as having been voted for at the primary election, and none of his votes shall be counted by the return judges; and in case of the refusal of any nominee to pay the fee hereinbefore required, or neglecting to do the same, he shall be dropped, and the person having the next highest vote in the convention, who has paid the said fee and complied with the provisions of this Act, shall be substituted on the ticket. If there be no nominee for any of the places on the ticket, the said convention of return judges shall select a candidate for such place, and in the event of any nominee dying or declining to have his name appear on the ticket the said committee shall have the name of the person receiving the next highest number of votes, provided he has complied with all the provisions of this Act, to be placed on the ballot; and in case of a tie for any place on the ballot, the return judges at said convention shall select publicly by lot a nominee from among the candidates so tied. If the expenditures for a candidate for nomination as set out in the affidavit of expenditures in this section provided for shall exceed the amounts of: For Judge of the Circuit Court, \$300; for Member of Congress, \$500; for State's Attorney, \$300; for Sheriff, \$300; for State Senator, \$100; for Clerk of Circuit Court, \$300; for Register of Wills, \$300; for Clerk to County Commissioners, \$100; for Treasurer, \$100; for Judge of the Orphans' Court, \$10; for County Commissioner, \$50; for House of Delegates, \$20; for County Surveyor, \$10—the said candidate shall be dropped, and the return judges shall not count the votes returned for such candidate, and only the names of the candidates whose expenditures do not exceed the amounts above specified shall be eligible for nomination.
