

more than ninety days in the jail of Allegany County, or both fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the court.

113C. Any member of an election board, or any registration officer, chairman of county committee, return judge or election supervisor, who shall fail to do and perform any of the duties required of him under the provisions of this Act, shall, upon indictment and conviction, be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and be subject to a fine of not less than fifty dollars nor more than two hundred dollars, or confinement in the jail of Allegany County for not less than thirty days nor more than six months, or both fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the court.

Failure to perform duties.

113D. No person, except those passing to and from the polls shall be allowed within twenty-five feet of the polls at any primary election, and not more than six persons desiring to cast their votes shall be allowed within said limits at any time, and it shall be the duty of the election officers to strictly enforce this section; and any person violating the provisions of this section shall be, upon conviction, adjudged guilty of a misdemeanor, and be subject to a fine of not less than ten dollars and not more than twenty-five dollars, or confinement in the county jail for not more than thirty days, or both fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the court.

Polling place limits.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

#### CHAPTER 509.

AN ACT to regulate the hunting, shooting or trapping of wild geese, wild duck, snipe, ortolan, reedbird, muskrat and all other birds and wild fowl on the Patuxent river, its tributaries, and the marshes of said river and its tributaries.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That it shall not be lawful for any person not a bona fide resident of the State of Maryland to hunt, shoot or trap within the State, upon the waters of the Patuxent river, its tributaries, or marshes of said river or tributaries, any wild goose, wild duck, snipe or ortolan, reedbird or birds or wild fowl of any description, at any season of the year, unless such non-resident person shall have first obtained from the Clerk of the Circuit Court of one of the counties bordering on said river a license
