

CHAPTER 530.

AN ACT to authorize the Board of County School Commissioners of Dorchester County to organize a high school, to be located in the town of Hurlock, in said county, and to appropriate certain moneys in the maintenance thereof.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Board of County School Commissioners of Dorchester County be and the same are hereby authorized to organize a high school, to be located in the town of Hurlock, in Dorchester County; and upon the organization thereof the said Board of County School Commissioners shall forward to the Comptroller of the Treasury of Maryland a certificate that the same hath been organized and that after receiving such certificate, the sum of five hundred dollars per annum be and the same is hereby appropriated to be paid by the State of Maryland to assist in the maintenance of such high school, and that the Comptroller of the Treasury of said State be and he is hereby authorized, directed and required, semi-annually, on the first day of January and the first of July, in each and every year, after receiving such certificate, to issue his warrant on the Treasurer of said State for the payment of the said sum of five hundred dollars, in two equal instalments as aforesaid, to the said Board of County School Commissioners for the use and benefit of the said high school.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 531.

AN ACT to prevent stock running at large in that part of District No. 10, Straits, known as Elliott's Island proper, being that part of Precinct No. 3 lying on the west side of Elliott creek and the east side of Fishing Bay in Dorchester County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That it shall not be lawful for stock of any kind to go at large without an attendant in that part of Precinct No. 3, District No. 10, lying to the westward of Elliott's creek, known as Elliott's Island proper, of said district, lying on the east side of Fishing Bay in Dorchester County.
