Bonds" if the ballot be cast for the issue, and "Against the Issue of Water Bonds" if the ballot be cast against the issue. The returns of said election shall be made in the same manner as is provided for the election of the Commissioners of Delmar, Maryland, and if a majority of the votes cast shall be against the issue of water bonds, then and in that case no bonds shall be issued, but if the majority of the votes cast shall be for the issue of water bonds, the Commissioners of Delmar, as hereinbefore provided for, may issue said bonds to the amount of ten thousand dollars, as hereinbefore provided

SEC. 11. And be it enacted, That in the event of any change from the present form of the local government of Delmar, Event of Maryland, that such officers who shall take the place of and act local governin the stead of the Commissioners and other officers in this Act mentioned shall be authorized to perform the duties and exercise the powers by this Act conferred upon the said Commissioners and other officers mentioned in their respective capacities, it being understood that the duties herein specified to be performed by the president of the Commissioners shall be performed by the Mayor if there shall be one.

SEC. 12. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 544.

AN ACT to authorize and direct the County Commissioners of St. Mary's County to levy a sum of money not exceeding four hundrd and fifty dollars to build a school house for white children at or near Hillville in the Sixth Eection Distriet of St. Marv's County.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the County Commissioners of St. Mary's County Levying monare hereby authorized and directed to levy a sum of money not eys to build a school exceeding four hundred and fifty dollars for the building of house. a school house for white children at the intersection of the Three Notch road and the road running to James' Wharf, near Hillville, in the Sixth Election District of St. Mary's County.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the Board of County School Commissioners of said county shall contract for the building
