

CHAPTER 550.

AN ACT to regulate the holding of camp and bush meetings in Anne Arundel County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That it shall not be lawful for any society, public or private, to hold camp meetings or bush meetings or other out-door meetings in Anne Arundel County for a longer period than two weeks in any one year in said county except by permission from the County Commissioners, and the said County Commissioners in their discretion may, on application, extend the time for such meeting as in their judgment they may deem expedient in additional to the term by this Act prescribed; for any violation of this the president or directors of said society, public or private, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction before a justice of the peace, such president or directors shall be fined for each offense not less than twenty-five dollars nor more than fifty dollars and costs, and in default of payment of said fine and costs, shall be committed to the county jail for a period of sixty days, unless sooner released by due process of law.

Regulating the holding of camp-meetings.

Violations.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 551.

AN ACT to prohibit hunting with a gun or rifle in Frederick County from the tenth day of October to the first day of November in each year or on election day.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That it shall not be lawful for anyone to hunt with a gun or rifle in Frederick County hereafter from the tenth day of October until the first day of November or on any election day in November of each year.

Prohibiting gunning on certain days.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That to carry around a gun or rifle in the field, woods or other such place in Frederick County within the abovementioned time shall be *prima facie* evidence of a violation of Section 1 of this Act.

Prima facie evidence.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That anyone violating the provisions of this Act, for each violation on his or their conviction before a justice of the peace of Frederick County shall forfeit

Penalty for violation of Act.
