SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the sum of five hundred dollars, or so much thereof Per diem, etc., as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated of National electors. to pay the per diem and mileage of the Electors of the President and Vice-President of the United States in and for the State of Maryland, their officers and attendants.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the Comptroller of the Treasury be and he is hereby directed to issue his warrant on Electoral Colthe Treasurer upon the certificate of the president and secretary of the Electoral College which shall assemble at Annapolis, Maryland, in the month of January, 1905, for such sums as may be due the several Electors aforesaid, their officers and attendants.

## CHAPTER 566.

AN ACT to authorize, empower and direct the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County to grant a pension of fifty dollars to James Godwin, of said county, and to levy said amount on the assessable property of said county.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County Granting a be and they are hereby authorized, empowered and directed county pension. to grant a pension of fifty dollars annually to James Godwin, of said county; said pension of fifty dollars to be paid quarterly of twelve dollars and fifty cents, during his natural life; and to levy said sum of fifty dollars of current money upon the assessable property of said county.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
