

CHAPTER 577.

AN ACT to amend Article 27 of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "Trading Stamps," by adding a section thereto, to follow Section 263H, and to be known as Section 263I.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Article 27 of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "Trading Stamps," be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto a section, to be known as 263I.

Trading stamps.

263I. No person shall sell or issue any stamp, trading stamp, cash discount stamp, check, ticket, coupon or other similar device, which will entitle the holder thereof, on presentation thereof, either singly or in definite number, to receive, either directly from the vendor or indirectly through any other person, money or goods, wares and merchandise, in which there shall be printed or written upon the face of each of said stamps, trading stamps, cash discount stamps, checks, tickets, coupons or other similar devices, a different redeemable value in merchandise from the redeemable value in money.

Restricting their sale or issue.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That all the penalties provided by Section 263G of Article 27 of the Code of Public General Laws, shall apply to a violation of Section 263I in the same manner as they applied to the original sections.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 578.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 22 of Article 23 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Wicomico County," sub-title "Delmar."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 22 of Article 23 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Wicomico County," sub-title "Delmar," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

Delmar, Wicomico County.

22. The taxable and corporate bounds and limits of said town of Delmar shall be as follows: Beginning for the same at a stone standing on the northeast corner of State street and
