

CHAPTER 580.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Talbot County, in the State of Maryland, in their discretion, to construct a bridge across Rolle's creek, in Talbot County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners of Talbot County be and they are hereby authorized and empowered, in their discretion, to construct a bridge across Rolle's creek, in Talbot County.

Authority to construct a bridge.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the said County Commissioners of Talbot County be and they are hereby authorized and empowered, in their discretion, to levy on the assessable property in said county, and collect a sufficient sum of money to pay the cost of constructing and maintaining said bridge and the causeways leading thereto.

Levying a tax for same.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 581.

AN ACT to authorize the Governor, the Comptroller of the Treasury and the Treasurer to sell, lease or otherwise dispose of to the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore the property of the State of Maryland, or any interest therein, situated within certain territorial limits in the City of Baltimore.

WHEREAS, By an Act recently passed by the General Assembly of Maryland creating the Burnt District Commission for the City of Baltimore, approved March 11, 1904, authority was conferred on said commission to acquire, in the name of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, by gift, grant, purchase or condemnation, all property, including also property belonging to the said State of Maryland, that might be necessary and requisite to lay out, open, widen, extend, straighten or close any street, lane or alley, or part thereof, in the Burnt District therein defined, and also to lay out additions and extensions to be made to the public wharves and docks of Balti-

To dispose of State property in the burnt district.
