CHAPTER 93.

A Supplement to an act entitled, an act to amend and re-duce into one system the laws to direct descents. Passed Mar. 4, 1834

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Mary-land, That hereafter in all cases where land has been sold by commissioners appointed under the act to which this is a supplement, or when any person has elected to take land under said act, the county court of the county where the land lies, upon being satisfied that the purchase money for said land has been paid or brought into court to the person or persons entitled to the same, may upon the application of the purchaser or person electing to take, or any other person who may have become entitled to said land, in any manner, order a deed of conveyance to be made to such purchaser or person entitled, and also appoint one of said commissioners, or in case of the death or absence of all of them, some other person to execute such deed, and that such deed when so executed by such commissioner or other person, and recorded as deeds are required by law to be executed and recorded, shall vest in the person or persons to whom the same may be made the legal title to said lands, as fully as if a deed had been made by all of the original commissioners, or a majority of them, as required by the act to which this is a supplement.
