CHAPTER 101.

An act for the incorporation of Miller Lodge, No. Eighteen, of the Order of Independent Odd Fellows, in Talbot county. Passed Mar. 1, 1834

Willson, William Colier, Edward Hale, David Hall, Howes Goldsborough and Henry Johnson, the officers and members of Miller Lodge, number eighteen, of the Order of Independent Odd Fellows, in Talbot county, and their successors, be, and they are hereby declared to be a community, corporation and body politic forever, by the name, style and title of Miller Lodge, number eighteen of the Order of Independent Odd Fellows; and by that name, they and their successors, shall and may at all times hereafter be capable in law to have, receive and retain to them and their successors, property real and personal; also, devises and bequests of any person or persons, bodies corporate or politic, capable of making the Persons incorporat-
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
