## CHAPTER 146.

Passed Mar. 5, 1834 A supplement to an act entitled, an act to authorise the drawing of a lottery or lotteries in Middletown, in Frederick county, passed at November session, eighteen hundred and nine, chapter sixty three.

Lottery act revived

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the visitors of the public school in Middletown shall be and they are hereby declared entitled to the benefit of the act to which this is a supplement, for the benefit of the said school; AND WHEREAS, a new mode of drawing lotteries has been introduced, and it may be doubtful whether the trustees aforesaid are authorised by the present act of Assembly to cause their lottery to be drawn according to such new mode, therefore,

Sec. 2. Be it enacted, That the visitors of the public school in Middletown, or any person or persons who have contracted for or purchased, or may hereafter contract for or purchase the right to the scheme of a lottery authorised to be drawn for their benefit, shall be at liberty to form, adopt and draw a scheme of said lottery, and upon such mode and upon such principles as shall or may be approved by the Governor and Council of Maryland.
