SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of CHAP. 12. Maryland, That Aaron Cain, William Armor, Samuel Persons incorpora-Rust, Joseph R. Foreman, George Teal, John Davis, Joseph McCubbin, John Couzens, Samuel MPherson, Edward Sweden, William McClean, Aaron McCubbin, Joshua McCubbin, William Wilbe, Charles Wilbe Joel Jones and others, that now are, or may hereafter become members of the said corporation herein erected, or may be admitted into the said corporation agreeably to the constitution, rules and by-laws of the same, and their successors, are hereby declared to be one community, corporation and body politic, by the name, style and title of Car-Title roll Beneficial Society of Baltimore; Provided nevertheless, that the said corporation may be dissolved at any time by May be dissolved the consent of its members, as is hereinafter provided.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the affairs of the said officers society shall be managed and conducted by a President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, five or more Stewards and a messenger, to be elected at such time and

place, as the said society may deem proper.

' Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That the present members of Power granted the said society and their successors, by their corporate name, shall, and may have perpetual succession, and shall, and may be, at all times hereafter, persons able and capable in law, to purchase, take, have and enjoy, to them and their successors in fee or lease, estate or estates, and lands, tenements, rents, annuities, chattels, United States' stock, bank stock, registered debts, or other public securities, within this state, by gift, purchase, or devise of or from any person or persons, body politic or corporate, capable to make the same, and the same at their pleasure to alien, sell, transfer or lease, in such manner as they may judge most conducive to the charitable uses of the said society: Provided nevertheless, that the said corporation shall not at any one time, hold or possess property, real, personal or mixed, exceeding in total value the sum of ten thousand dollars.

Sec. 4. And be it enacted, That the members of the said Meetings corporation and their successors may meet together at such time and place as the said society may deem proper, and then and there elect the officers of the said society, and choose officers form such rules and regulations, and enact such by-laws as Make By laws may be necessary for assuring and carrying into effect the benevolent purposes of this act: Provided, such rules, re-
