CHAP. 167. first section of this act, are hereby constituted Trustees, with full power and authority to receive as Trustees, and convey the title to the within property.

Confirmations required

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That the proceeding of the commissioners to be appointed in virtue of the first section of this act shall be of no force or effect until confirmed by the Levy court of Worcester county.

Oath required

Sec. 4. And be it enacted, That the commissioners appointed in virtue of the first section of this act before they proceed to execute the duties enjoined on them by this act, shall first make oath before some person qualified to administer oaths in this state, that they will, well and truly perform the duties required of them by this act of Assembly.

CHAPTER 167.

An additional Supplement to the act entitled, an act to provide for the appointment of Commissioners for the regulation and improvement of Snow Hill, in Worcester county.

reamble

Whereas, it has been represented to this General Assembly by a petition of sundry citizens of Snow Hill, in Worcester county, that by opening a street at some point on Washington street, at or near its junction with Spence's alley, and running north and castwardly parallel, or nearly parallel with Market street, would be of utility to the public, and of no serious injury to any one in the town—Therefore,

Authority to open a street

Maryland, That the commissioners of the town be, and they are hereby authorized at their discretion to make public a street twenty-five feet wide, in Snow Hill Town, leading from a point on Washington street, at or near its junction with Spence's alley, running North and Eastwardly, parallel with Market street, and the said commissioners or a majority of them are hereby authorized and empowered at their discretion to open the said street the width aforesaid, and in that way which will be the least injurious to the persons through whose lots the same may be opened; Provided always, that the same street shall not be opened through any person's yard, or garden, without his or her consent.
