Sec. 8. And be it enacted, That the court of Chancery or Baltimore county court respectively, may at discretion, May appoint other trustices from time to time, appoint any other Trustee or Trustees in place of these appointed by the decree aforesaid; and that the proceeds of sales aforesaid shall be accounted for Proceeds accountto the courts respectively, and distributed in manner as is usual in cases of sales under decrees of said courts of mortgaged property.

## CHAPTER 182.

An additional supplement to the act entitled, an act relating Passed Mar. 11,1834 to the city of Bultimore, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and seventeen.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Indivision of real Maryland, That where real estate within the city of Baltimore has been or may be hereafter divided, according to law, among heirs, legatees, joint tenants or tenants in common, entitled to the same, and such division calls for any if calls for streets, of the streets, lanes or alleys, or any part or parts thereof, as surveyed and laid off under the act of Assembly to which this is a supplement, or reserve any of the said streets, Authority granted lanes or alleys, or any part or parts thereof as open, and disposition divides such estate with reference thereto, that the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore be and they are hereby authorised, on the application of one or more persons interested in the ground to be taken on such application, to adopt and sanction by ordinance the principle upon which such division was had, and to open any of the said streets, And open said lanes or alleys, or any part or parts thereof, in the said division reserved and recognized: Provided, that the ground Proviso over which the said street, lane or alley, or part thereof passes, be at the time of such application in fact unenclosed and unimproved: Provided, that at least one week's Notice required notice in the newspapers of said city, (the cost of the advertisements to be paid by the applicants,) be given of such application before any such ordinance shall pass.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That all or any of the streets, Declared public highways lanes or alleys, or any part or parts thereof, opened in the manner hereinbefore directed, be and are hereby declared to be public highways, and to be subject to the laws, regulations and ordinances applicable to public streets, lanes or alleys, or part or parts thereof, in the city of Baltimore.
