Sec. 5. And be it enacted, That the pastor or any member of the said corporation shall have full power and authority to adjourn from day to day until a quorum shall attend; and the said corporation are hereby authorised and empowered to appoint and employ a fit and proper person as register of the said corporation, whose duty it shall be register to keep a fair and regular account of their proceedings, which shall be subject to the inspection of any of the members belonging to the said congregation.

## CHAPTER 192.

An act for the relief of John H. Dorsey.

Passed Mar. 12,1834

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That compromise the commissioners for Baltimore county be and they hereby are fully authorised to make such compromise as they may deem proper and for the interest of said county, with John H. Dorsey, late a collector of taxes in said county, and also with both or either of his sureties.

## CHAPTER 193.

An act to Incorporate the town commonly called and known Passed Mar. 12,1834 by the name of Manchester and Germantown, in Baltimore county, under the common name of Manchester.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Citizens incorpora-Maryland, That the citizens of the town, commonly called and known by the name of Manchester and Germantown, in Baltimore county, shall be and they are hereby constituted and made a body corporate, under the common name Name, &c. of the Commissioners of Manchester, with all the privileges of a body corporate, and to have a common seal and perpetual succession.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the free male white citi-qualification to zens of Manchester aforesaid, of the age of twenty-one years and upwards, and who have resided in the said place for and during the space of six months next preceding the election, shall on the first Saturday of May next in each
