

AND WHEREAS, at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-two, the Levy court of Prince George's county, was authorised at their discretion to ^{CHAP. 250} the use of Thomas Edmonson, of said county ^{For Edmonson} and the said court having failed to do the same, therefore, *Be it enacted*, that the Levy court of Prince George's county, be and they are hereby authorised and required at their next levy to levy on the assessable property of said county for the use of the said Edmonson, thirty dollars, to be collected and payed as all other county charges are levied and collected.

CHAPTER 258.

An act limiting the time for the collection of the Fees of ^{Passed Mar. 16, 1834}
Attorneys, Solicitors, Clerks, Registers, Sheriffs and other officers of the State.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of* ^{Limitation 3 years}
Maryland, That the fees of Attorneys, Solicitors, Clerks, Registers, Sheriffs, Collector of county levies, Constables and other officers in this state hereafter to become due shall be collected in three years from the date of such fee or fees, and not after.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That all fees due previous to ^{Previous accounts}
the passage of this act, shall be collected within three years from the passage of this act and not after.

CHAPTER 259.

An act for the relief of Vincent DeCamp, of the City of ^{Passed Mar. 18, 1834}
Baltimore.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That ^{Insolvent}
the commissioners of Insolvent debtors, for the city and county of Baltimore, be, and they are hereby authorised and empowered, to grant to Vincent DeCamp, of the city of Baltimore, the benefit of the several acts of Assembly, passed for the relief of insolvent debtors, *Provided*, the said Vincent DeCamp shall in all respects (except that of prov-
