CHAP. 263.

CHAPTER 262.

Passed Mar. 15, 1834

*An act supplementary to the act, passed at December session eighteen hundred and thirty one, extending the powers of executors of wills and testaments, and for other purposes.*

Compensation for selling estate

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That in all cases where an executor shall hereafter sell real estate of a testator or testatrix, by virtue of last will and testament, and shall account to the Orphans' court of the county, in which letters testamentary were granted, as is directed by the provisions of the act of which this is a supplement, the said court may allow such executor or executrix, a commission on the proceeds of sales of such real estate, not less than two per cent, nor more than ten per cent.

Repeal

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That all parts of the act of which this is a supplement, that are inconsistent with this act, be and they are hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 263.

Passed Mar. 15, 1834

*An act for the payment of the Journal of Accounts.*

WHEREAS, it appears by the Journal of Accounts, of this session, that there is due from this state, the sum of forty thousand eight hundred and ninety one dollars and eighteen cents current money;—Therefore,

Payment authorized

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the treasurer of the Western shore, be, and he is hereby authorised and required to pay to the several persons, their executors, administrators, assigns or orders, or to such of them as shall apply to receive the same, the several sums of money allowed to them respectively, as they appear to be settled and ascertained by the said journal of accounts, out of any money now in the treasury; subject to appropriation by the general assembly,
