

RESOLUTIONS.

No. 9.

Passed Jan. 21, 1834 Resolution allowing Samuel Pool to compound on his certificate of Survey.

WHEREAS, by an act passed at December session, eighteen hundred and twenty-two, chapter one hundred and twenty eight, it was provided by the third section thereof, that all certificates of surveys of land made in Allegany county, after the passage of said act, and returned to the land office of the Western Shore, shall be compounded on within twelve months from the date of such certificate of survey, or become null and void, and the laws therein contained, be liable to be again taken up, as other vacant lands in said county; AND WHEREAS, it appears that Samuel Pool had surveyed and laid off a tract of land called Cannon, containing eighty-one, and one-eighth acres of land in said county and made return of the certificate, the time prescribed by law having expired in October, eighteen hundred and thirty-three, for the payment of the composition money, hence the Treasurer of the Western Shore is prohibited from receiving the same—Therefore,

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Samuel Pool, be, and he is hereby allowed further time to compound on his certificate of survey, called Cannon, containing eighty-one and one-eighth acres, until the fifteenth February, eighteen hundred and thirty-four, any law to the contrary notwithstanding; provided nevertheless, that any rights acquired to said land by any other person or persons, since the issuing of said warrant, shall not be affected by this resolution.

No. 10.

Passed Jan. 23. Resolution in favor of Elie Ridgely, of Allegany county.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Elie Ridgely, of Allegany county, be and he is hereby authorised to compound on his certificate of resurvey, called Roanoke, lying in the county aforesaid, and containing four hundred and fifty acres of land, and that said certificate, after it shall have been compounded on and returned to the Land office, shall be as valid to all intents and purposes as
