Resolution in favor of Ann Tredway.

*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the commissioners of Harford county, be, and they are hereby authorised and required to pay to Ann Tredway, widow of the late Edward Tredway, formerly crier to Harford county court, or to her order, whatever sum of money the said commissioners shall adjudge to have been due to said crier, under the provisions of resolution number three, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty one.*
