Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore, be, and he is hereby authorised and required to pay to Mary Coe, widow of Wiliam Coe, or to her order during life, in quarter yearly payments, a sum of money equal to the half pay of a Matross, in consideration of the services rendered by her husband during the revolutionary war.

Resolution in favor of Nancy Jones.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore, be, and he is hereby authorised and required to pay to Nancy Jones, of Worcester county, or to her order during life, in quarter yearly payments, a sum of money equal to the half pay of a Private, in consideration of the services rendered by her husband during the revolutionary war.
